

# Daily Prayer for Peace

The **Daily Prayer for Peace** is a spiritual discipline unique to the [Community of Christ](#) and practiced at the [Independence Temple](#) in the church's headquarters campus in [Independence, Missouri](#). It falls within the most common category of [Christian prayer](#) known as [supplication](#). Each day of the year at 1 p.m. [Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Time](#) a Daily Prayer for Peace is held as part of a brief worship for that purpose held in the sanctuary of the Independence Temple. The sanctuary is open to the public as members lead a brief worship service that includes the Daily Prayer for Peace. The form of the prayer is a public spoken prayer, usually written by one of the members from somewhere in the world and read aloud either by that member or another person. Each day of the year, the Daily Prayer for Peace is focused on the needs of a different nation of the world. The supplicant prays aloud for peace under the 150-foot dome of the temple spire.(Cont. page 3)
